Created in 1875 by Francesco Peloni, a pharmacist from Bormio, Braulio captures the distinctive aromas and flavors of the alpine flora. Braulio's name comes from the Mount Braulio that overlooks the marvelous area.

TASTE PROFILE:

Braulio has a very robust and intense taste of herbs and essential oils, followed by classic notes of wood and roots, finished with pleasant bitterness. The flavor is characterized by yarrow, juniper berries, wormwood and gentian root. It is rested in Slavonian oak barrels to create a balance of flavors and an unmatched bouquet of aromas.

Braulio is an amaro and perfect served straight with or without ice after a meal.
